**FUNDING OPPORTUNITY:** The Asia Foundation announces a call for proposals for funding of projects and activities under the Civil Society Fund (CSF) of the South Asia Water Governance Program (SAWGP). Over a two year period (2016-2017), the Fund will support civil society and community engagement on transboundary water issues in the South Asia region.

**GEOGRAPHIC SCOPE:** Regional engagements in two or more of the following countries: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, India, Nepal and Pakistan.
