Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Leads management and outreach to key Chinese and US government agencies, industry associations and thinktanks, including submitting and discussing proposed projects, facilitating member company interaction, and coordinating personnel and technical exchanges. (25%).
- Identifies, recruits, and retains member companies for the premium program. Sets recruitment and retention targets and manages outreach to potential members. Support the Membership team for the recruitment of general membership in the energy-related sector (25%).
- Develops and manages project activities in the form of training, workshops, symposia, and studies that showcase US regulatory and business best practices, new technologies, and pertinent information exchanges (20%).
- Financial/Budget Management and team management. (10%)

- Academic background: Master's degree and above in energy-related fields.
- At least 7 years of work experience in energy-related companies, industry associations, governmental institutions, or international organizations.
- A proven track record of working cooperatively with Chinese governmental institutions, preferably in the energy sector; experience working with the US government is a plus.
